We have split the program into **two, half-week sessions** to accommodate family schedules and boys who are camping away from home for the first time.

LEADERSHIP POLICY

PARENTS OF PARTICIPANTS NEED NOT ATTEND!

It is the policy of the Boy Scouts of America that **at least 2 adult leaders**, one of whom must be 21 years of age or older, are required for all Troops/ Packs camping as a unit. Camp Strang maintains a 5 to 1 ratio during Webelos week. Volunteer den leaders are responsible for a group of boys during the week. Parents are asked to pass along any pertinent information to the Den Leader during check-in to help ensure that the Leader is prepared to give each camper the best experience possible. **Some pack leaders choose to split the week.**

WEBELOS RESIDENT CAMP

WEBELOS PROGRAM

The Webelos Program is centered around providing a fun and educational experience for boys. Each den is assigned to a campsite together with a den leader. The den stays together for the duration of the week as they follow a structured program during the morning. Afternoon activities may vary.

TYPICAL DAY

6:30– Polar Bear Swim
8:00– Breakfast
9–12– Morning activities
12:30– Lunch
1:00– Siesta
2–4– Afternoon activities
5:00– Free Swim
6:00– Dinner
7–8– Evening Program
8:00– Fires in sites/ den time
9:30– Lights out

CHECK-IN PROCEDURE:

Campers attending the first session may arrive after **5:00pm for check-in on Wednesday** evening. Scouts are to register at the check-in tent adjacent to the parking lot. **Swim tests will not be conducted during check-in.** Parents are encouraged to stay for our opening picnic, camp tour, and opening campfire. The first half session ends after **lunch (1:00pm) on Saturday.** Scouts are to check-out at the registration tent adjacent to the parking lot.

The next half session starts **at lunch on Saturday.** Scouts are to register at the check-in tent adjacent to the parking lot. Parents of all participants are encouraged to attend the closing picnic, court of honor, and campfire on **Tuesday** starting at **6:00pm.**
