WHERE: Edmund D. Strang Scout Reservation, Goshen, CT

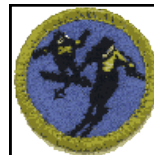
WHEN: Friday, February 17, 2012 - 7:00 PM to

WHO: Registered Boy Scouts and Venture Crew Members must be **12 years of age** at time of event **and First Class Rank**.

COST: \$135.00 which includes all meals, program supplies, ski lift tickets, rifle range. (Does not include ski rentals, or merit badge books). Each Scout must have their own MB book.

- **A completed BSA medical form must accompany this application.**
• **NO EXCEPTIONS!!!**
- **You must have your Scoutmaster's approval on the application**
- **If your son has a food allergy, or any disorder contact Jim Butler via phone at 203-736-6449 prior to registration to discuss the severity and how to manage the condition.**
- Activities will be held at the training center which is heated, has electricity, hot showers and kitchen. We will also use the Teirney Lodge which has a wood stove. Scouts who stay in the Teirney Lodge will have access to the Training Center facility.
- Youth members will be supervised by a minimum of two adults at all times.
- **You must work on at least 4 merit badges including the prerequisites!**
- Boys will work on the following Merit Badges; Snow Sports, Safety, Space Exploration, Engineering, Disability Awareness, Farm Mechanics, Genealogy, Communications, Rifle Shooting (first 8 to Register that have a partial), Shot Gun Shooting (First 6 to Reregister and age 14). There are prerequisites for the Merit Badges that must be completed before attending. Prerequisites will be communicated under separate distribution. A Scout may not complete all the requirements for all of the Merit Badges offered during Winter Camp. For instance Snow Sports generally takes two years to complete on average for novice skiers.
- Rifle and Shot Gun may conflict with the other merit badges being offered.
- There will be an opportunity to attend Mohawk Mountain for skiing. Lift tickets are included. If needed, there will be an extra rental charge of for skis/snowboards and helmets. Helmets are required at your cost.
- For health and safety reasons, please have your son stay home if he is sick. We have had incidents in the past where stomach bugs infected Camp. Our goal is to have a fun, healthy and safe environment for your son to advance.
