You must be a registered scouter willing to learn and have a good time! You have to complete all 6 parts of the Minuteman Course in order to receive your Minuteman patch and bolo. In addition to the two courses above, **Boy Scout Leader Fast Start**, **This is Scouting** (or have previously taken New Leader Essentials), **Youth Protection Training** and **Troop Committee Challenge** must be taken online at www.myscouting.org Login or set up your account. You will need your membership number, located on your membership card, to create your account profile. Click on Training. Look for courses under Boy Scout and General tabs. You must present your training certificates for these four trainings in order to qualify for the Minuteman designation. Youth Protection Training is in effect for 2 years from your date of training. All other courses must only be taken once. Therefore, if you have taken any of the courses in the past, you do not have to take that course again.
